This substantial period building is situated on the south side of Emperors Gate off Grenville Place, close to Imperial College and right in the middle of the many study abroad programmes in South Kensington. Gloucester Road underground station (District, Circle and Piccadilly Lines) is within a few minutes walk.

The property comprises a large reception room (almost 400 SQ FT) where we will be able to host Shabbat and holiday celebrations as well as other educational and social events for the students. There is also a kitchen, office and toilets.

## VITAL PROPOSAL FOR CHABAD OF SOUTH KENSINGTON

The "Campus" branch of Chabad Lubavitch UK has been actively servicing students in South Kensington since 1970's with classes on campus and social events. In 2008 the activities expanded to include a full time "Chabad House" acting as a vital Jewish lifeline and home away from home for students and faculty of the many universities in the area, including Imperial College and the many study abroad programmes.

Recently Chabad of South Kensington hosted the largest Seder in the UK at the Imperial College Union Concert Hall, as well as a Menorah Lighting with Lord Robert Winston at the Queens Tower in Imperial College .

The Chabad house has been running out of rented facilities since its full time status in 2008 and has seen major growth. From 100 students at our first year's Seder to 300 at our second year's Seder. From 15 students at our first Friday night Shabbat to 60 students at our recent Indian Shabbat dinner.

To accommodate this fast pace of growth we have moved flats often. Over the past three years, we have moved five times. The time and need has now come that we rent a commercial property to house the vital Chabad House activities.
